Dear Mr., Anderson District Director,

Thank you for the update. It has come to my attention that two very significant documents have been scrubbed from my portal. These were my response in a timely manner as required to the response Home Depot provided. I am enclosing a copy of one of them for your review. I had two copies of the same document posted and both have disappeared. The reason I had two is that there was a typo in the first sentence of the original and to help I sent the second one with the typo corrected.

I emailed Mercedes with a question how this happened, and she replied it was on the new portal. I asked to have access to see it and received no response.
