- *The ant works hard in the withering heat all summer long, building his house and laying up **supplies for the winter. *
- *The grasshopper thinks the ant is a fool and laughs and dances and plays the summer away. He purchases a big home with a reverse mortgage and buys a Hum Vee for no money down and a six year note. Come winter, the shivering grasshopper calls a press conference and demands to know why the ant is entitled be warm and well fed while victims like him are cold and starving. CBS, NBC, PBS, CNN, and ABC show up to provide pictures of the shivering grasshopper next to a video of the ant in his comfortable home with a table filled with food. They assume the position of moral outrage as the grasshopper comes ever closer to death. Experts are interviewed to detail the dying process that is inevitable and caused by the ant's greed and avarice.
- *America is stunned by the sharp contrast. How can this be, that in a country of such wealth, this poor grasshopper is allowed to suffer so? *
- *Kermit the Frog appears on Oprah with the grasshopper, and everybody cries when they **sing, 'It's Not Easy Being Green.' Ophrah states that there are many ways of faith to reach the glorious divinity and encourages the grasshopper to find his. She pledges to build a statute to the memory of the grasshopper lest his demise be forgotten. She is unable to provide succor

because the grass hopper fails to meet her perceived requirements.

Jesse Jackson arrives with his traveling paid bus loads of professional agitators to stage a demonstration in front of the ant's house. His Rainbow Coalition threatens boycotts of any business doing business with the ant. Jesse then has the group kneel down to pray to his god for the grasshopper's sake.

Nancy Pelosi, John Kerry, Obama, McCain & Harry Reid exclaim in an interview with Larry King that the ant has gotten rich off the back of the grasshopper, and call for an immediate tax hike on the ant to make him pay his fair share. The ant and grasshopper are morally equivalent.

The ACLU senses an opportunity and determine this is a great case. They sue the ant on behalf of the grasshopper for violating the civil rights of the grasshopper and engaging in hate speech, EEOC and RICO activities. The Government does the same.
